



Doug Sanders, 1970 British Open. A miss from three feet on the 72nd hole dropped him into a play off with Jack Nicklaus, which he lost.

Greg Norman, 1996 Masters. Shot a 78 to become the only player to blow a six-stroke lead after 54 holes in a major.
