- Paul Azinger and the U.S. Ryder Cup Team Paul tinkered with the Ryder Cup qualifying rules and made a great run
- Anthony Kim Beat Sergio and was an emotional leader of the Ryder Cup Team

Losers

- Sergio Garcia Still did not win a major but had a great win at The Players Championship
- Phil Mickelson Lackluster year, with only two wins and some weak performances in the Majors and Ryder Cup
- The Australians Greg Norman got some solid ink with his British Open play and the young guns Geoff Ogilvy and Adam Scott did well
- The FedEx Cup FedEx could continue to lose luster with the advent of the Race to Dubai next year.
